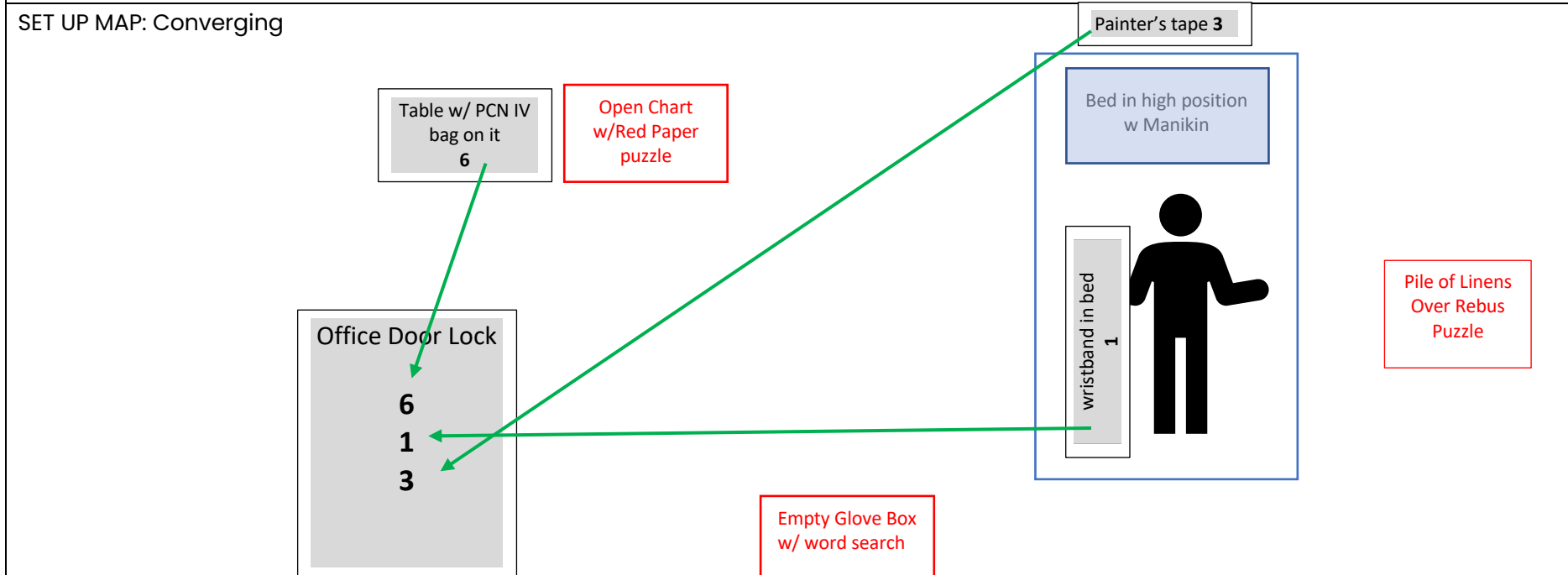
**LEARNING OBJECTIVES:**

Utilize effective communication skills when working with your team.  
Demonstrate collaboration while problem solving.

<b>LOCK/PUZZLE DESCR.</b>	<b>LOCATION</b>	<b>SOLUTION</b>	<b>CLUE(S)</b>	<b>LEADS TO</b>
Wristband with a small piece of painter's tape with the number <b>1</b> written on it	In patient bed next to arm	Put wristband back on patient wrist after confirming identity	"What is the patient's name?"	One of the final lock digits
Piece of painter's tape with the number <b>3</b> taped onto the wall hidden behind the headboard	Bed in high position	When bed is lowered the tape is visible	Patient states, "Why am I sitting so high up?"	One of the final lock digits
PCN listed as allergy on wristband/ PCN IVPB bag on the table with the number <b>6</b> on a piece of painter's tape on the back	Patient wristband	Notify charge nurse that the patient has a med in his room that he is allergic to	Pt asks "when will I be receiving my antibiotic"	One of the final lock digits
<b>DISTRACTORS THAT STILL SHOULD TO BE SOLVED</b>				
Red Paper Puzzle with the following message: What is the website to look up the Joint Commission Patient Safety Goals? _ _ _ _ _	Lying in the Open Chart with the corner visible within the chart	Close the chart, return it to the nurses' station and solve the puzzle with the red plastic decoder that was placed somewhere in the room	NA	Distractor
Pile of linens on the floor with a Rebus puzzle underneath (tape it to the floor if you think it may be overlooked among the linens) [PUZZLE of your choice using the rebus generator...ie a patient safety goal]	Pile of linens on the floor with a Rebus puzzle underneath	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Remove linen from floor and place in linen hamper</li> <li>2. Determined by your choice of Rebus puzzle content</li> </ol>	NA	Distractor
Empty Glove box with word search of PPE related content or terms (max 8 words to make sure too much time is not used on this step)	Glove box holder	Determined by your choice of search words	NA	Distractor
<b>FINAL ESCAPE</b> <b>(3 Digit Lock printed on a paper)</b>	Taped to the closed "office" door	<b>6-1-3</b>	Which safety violations are "sticky"?	Successful escape!
